RUDY'S ROCKIN' PRETZELS

12 oz. Orville Redenbacher popcorn oil
1 tsp garlic powder
1/2 tsp onion powder
2 TBS dill
1 envelope Hidden Valley Ranch Dressing Mix
2 bags (16 oz each) mini pretzels

1. Whisk all ingredients together and transfer to a large ziploc bag.
2. Add pretzels to ziploc bag, seal and shake so all pretzels are covered.
3. Place in 300 degree oven for 30 minutes or so, stirring every 10 minutes until all oil is absorbed.
